- c) for a non-Indigenous student enrolled in a post-graduate degree program at NCEPH, and working in the area of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health, to travel to undertake national or international travel in pursuit of their academic goals (e.g. to attend a conference, training, workshop, or collaborative meeting).
