PETER AND LENA KARMEL HONOURS SCHOLARSHIP IN MUSIC

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. INTRODUCTION

Each year, there shall be a scholarship for award known as the Peter and Lena Karmel Honours Scholarship in Music.

2. VALUE

- 2.1 The value of the Scholarship shall be outlined in the formal scholarship letter of offer.
- 2.2 The Scholarship does not provide exemption from payment under the Commonwealth Supported Students HECS-HELP Scheme, or International Student Fees.

3. ELIGIBILITY

All students approved to undertake the Honours year in the Bachelor of Music degree will automatically be considered for the Peter and Lena Karmel Honours Scholarship in Music.

4. APPLICATION

- 4.1 Applicants applying to enter the Bachelor of Music Honours year from another institution must meet the entry requirements for the School of Music in the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences and must demonstrate outstanding musical ability and accomplishment which will be assessed at audition and interview. All external Honours applicants will be automatically considered, and therefore will not be required to formally apply for a scholarship.
- 4.2 Current ANU students wishing to enter Honours will be automatically assessed at their Year 3 assessment.

5. SELECTION

- 5.1 The Scholarship will be awarded on the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising the Head of the School of Music and one or more academic staff of the School of Music as appropriate. The Committee shall select a candidate for the Scholarship from external applicants at audition and interview, or from continuing ANU students at the Year 3 assessment.
- 5.2 The Committee shall select for the Scholarship a person who, in the opinion of the Committee, is deemed to display an outstanding level of musical accomplishment and possess the potential to make an outstanding contribution to music.

6. CONCURRENT HOLDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A scholar must obtain permission from the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences to hold any other scholarship or award concurrently with the Peter and Lena Karmel Honours Scholarship.



7. DEFERMENT

Deferment of the commencement of a program is not available to students in the ANU School of Music. The Scholarship will be taken up at the commencement of the academic year or semester in which it is offered.

8. COMMENCEMENT

The Scholarship commences from the start of the teaching period in the first semester in which it is offered, unless otherwise stated in the letter of offer or approved by the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences.

9. LEVEL OF PERFORMANCE

A scholar is normally expected to achieve an average grade of Distinction in each semester during the tenure of the Scholarship.

10. TENURE

The Scholarship is tenable, subject to satisfactory academic progress, for one academic year of the undergraduate degree program as set out in the letter of offer or as subsequently approved by the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences.

11. ENROLMENT

- 11.1 The Scholarship is awarded on the condition that the scholar is enrolled in a full-time Honours year leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Music with Honours at the Australian National University.
- 11.2 A scholar is expected to be in attendance at the University at the commencement of the first teaching period and to remain in full-time enrolment during the University teaching periods or semesters.
- 11.3 If a scholar is absent from the University through illness or for any other reason, approval for program leave must be obtained from the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences. Approval must also be obtained from the Dean to suspend the scholarship whilst on any approved program leave.

12. TERMINATION

The Scholarship normally terminates at the conclusion of the year for which it has been awarded. The University may terminate the Scholarship before this time if the scholar does not fulfil her/his obligations or if, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, satisfactory academic progress in the approved course is not being made by the scholar.

13. REPAYMENT OF FUNDS

The scholarship instalment for the semester in which the enrolment change or withdrawal occurred may be requested to be refunded. The determination will be made by the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Science taking into account information from the scholar and the Head of the School of Music.



14. PUBLICITY

It is anticipated that the Peter and Lena Karmel Honours Scholarship holder may be requested to participate in publicity of the Scholarship from time to time. A scholar may be contacted for an interview and photograph. The University may also publicise the Scholarship by publishing the name of the scholar. Arrangements for such publicity will be made through the Communications and External Liaison Office of the University.
