

Chancellor's International Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

General Questions

1. Is there a separate application for the ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship?

No, there is no separate application. All eligible international students applying for admission will be automatically considered.

2. Will the scholarship be available for future intakes?

Yes, the ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship is currently available for students commencing in 2026.

3. What does the scholarship cover?

This is a tuition fee waiver scholarship. The value of the scholarship will be deducted from your tuition fees each semester for the duration of your degree (undergraduate or postgraduate).

4. When and how will recipients receive their scholarship offer?

Scholarship offers are released after academic admission offers. Recipients will receive their scholarship offer via email (and their agent, if applicable).

5. Will students who are not awarded the scholarship be notified?

No. Only students who receive a scholarship will be sent a separate scholarship offer letter following their academic offer.

6. I received a 25% tuition fee reduction. Can I still be considered for the 50% scholarship?

All eligible applicants are first considered for the 50% scholarship. If not selected, they are then considered for the 25% scholarship.

7. How long do I have to accept my scholarship offer?

The deadline is stated in your scholarship offer letter.

8. How do I accept my scholarship offer?

You must accept both your academic and scholarship offers separately. Follow the instructions in your scholarship offer letter and return the signed document to:

9. Is there a list of countries for each award category or region?

Yes. Country classifications are available via the Australian Bureau of Statistics under the Standard Australian Classification of Countries (SACC):

Concurrent Holding of Awards

1. Can students hold two scholarships at the same time?

Yes, depending on the type of scholarship. You may hold the ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship (an Academic scholarship) alongside an Access (equity) scholarship. However, students may only hold one Academic scholarship at a time.

Example:

You may hold the ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship and an Access scholarship offered by another ANU department.

2. Can students hold two ANU Chancellor's International Scholarships?

No, students cannot hold more than one ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship.

Scholarship Payment Information

1. Will the scholarship amount be paid to my bank account or deducted from tuition fees?

The scholarship amount will be deducted from your tuition fees at the start of each semester.

2. Do I still need to pay a deposit to begin my studies?

Yes. You must pay the deposit stated in your offer letter and the remaining tuition balance each semester.

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3. I've already paid my tuition fees and have a credit. What should I do?

You can either leave the credit in your account to cover future fees or apply for a refund.

Change of Preference, Deferrals, and Transfers

1. Can international students defer their offers?

No. International students cannot defer either their academic or scholarship offers.

2. If a student declines the scholarship or accepts another, will others be reconsidered?

Yes. Declined offers may be reallocated to other eligible students in subsequent offer rounds.

3. What happens if I change my program preference in a later round?

If places are available, you may receive a new scholarship offer aligned with your updated academic offer.

4. If I don't receive a scholarship offer, can I be considered in a later round?

Yes. You may change your preference or intake and be reconsidered in the next monthly round.

Note: Changing your preference forfeits your current academic offer.

Partner University Students

1. Are students from partner universities (e.g., 2+2 programs) eligible?

Yes. Students enrolling at ANU for the first time through partner programs will be considered and notified like general applicants.
