When do applications open?

Applications open every year on the 1st of May and close at 14th July (11.59pm AEST).

After the close date, applications are shortlisted for two rounds of interviews that take place between August and October - for exact interview dates keep an eye on the website. After the interview process has been completed 15-20 Scholarships will be awarded.

How do I apply?

Mission of the General Sir John Monash Foundation:

To invest in outstanding Australians from all fields of endeavour who demonstrate remarkable qualities of leadership and have the ability to deliver outcomes and inspire others for the benefit of Australia.

What makes it different to other Scholarships?

- o Uniquely Australia Scholarships, established in Australia for Australian citizens, for the benefit of Australia.
- o Open for people of all ages and from all fields of endeavour to undertake a postgraduate degree (Masters, PhD or equivalent degree) overseas.
- o Not restricted by where you would like to complete your postgraduate degree overseas, as long as you can demonstrate why it is the best place in the world for you to be.

What is it worth?

- o Annual stipend of \$70,000 a year for up to 3 years of postgraduate study (depending on the length of the degree at a full-time study load).
- o Support to get to the location of your postgraduate study overseas from Australia.

Eligibility criteria:

- o Australian citizenship
- Must have completed (or will have by the year following application and selection) a degree from an Australian higher education institution.
- o Plan to commence a Masters or PhD at an overseas institution the year after application and selection.

Key selection criteria:

- o Demonstrated excellence in your field
- o Demonstrated or potential leadership ability
- o A vision to deliver a positive impact for the benefit of Australia
